Job Description

- Perform work involving the skills of maintenance or craft occupations to keep machines, mechanical equipment, or the structure of a facility in repair. Experience is a plus.
- Must demonstrate safety when using construction tools in and around our store's and associates.
- Must be a self starter and needs to express quality service to our stores and demonstrate people skills to our associates.

Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Perform preventative maintenance skills related to general up-keep of our stores.
- Maintain a professional, courteous manner with all customers, vendors, contractors and fellow employees.
- Maintain tools and/or equipment for the purpose of ensuring the availability of equipment in safe operating condition.
- Keep company vehicle neat, organized, clean and in good operating condition.
